Entertaining tours and workshop activities for families and children, tactile tours and guided tours in LIS (Italian Sign Language) for adults and children

The VIVE is an important historical and artistic heritage site for the city of Rome, Italy and the international public who visit the capital. It offers a wide selection of free educational activities, allowing visitors of all ages to learn about the famous Vittoriano monument, the Central Museum of the Risorgimento and Palazzo Venezia, including its gardens, historic reception rooms and museum.

The programme of events for April and May includes new tour itineraries: *VIVE family tour, Vittoriano Manifesto!* and *Plein-air painting in the Rediscovered Garden*, as well as two special programmes for the Easter holidays and Liberation Day.

VIVE's entertaining family tours allow an audience of adults and children alike to experience new views of the city, through the creation of a new storytelling tour that links the various sites together and explains how they have transformed over time.

The dramatised tours and the plein-air painting workshop are designed to explore the gardens of Palazzo Venezia, to learn to look at nature with new eyes and to explore art and botany using creativity and imagination.

The accessible activities include guided tours in LIS (Italian Sign Language) and tactile tours for adults and children, making VIVE an accessible place that is open to a wide variety of visitors. The VIVE family tour is an entertaining guided tour that is offered in English for families - both tourists and residents of the city of Rome - who wish to practice the English language in a fun way that includes art, history and culture to discover the Vittoriano and Palazzo Venezia.

EASTER SPECIAL AT THE VIVE - From 15 to 19 April 2022, during the Easter holidays, VIVE offers a free programme of entertaining and dramatised guided tours, dedicated to families and children, allowing visitors to explore all the wonders of the Vittoriano and Palazzo Venezia. LIBERATION DAY SPECIAL AT THE VITTORIANO - From 23 to 25 April 2022, VIVE has organised a free programme of entertaining guided tours for families of the Vittoriano and the Central Museum of the Risorgimento to celebrate the anniversary of Liberation Day and learn about history in a child-friendly manner.

WHAT'S NEW ON THE PROGRAMME OF EVENTS

\rightarrow VIVE Family tour

Entertaining guided tour in English for families of Palazzo Venezia and the Vittoriano

At VIVE, visitors can take in a panoramic view of Rome from above, retrace the majestic settings of the film *The Belly of the Architect* by Peter Greenaway, walk through the spectacular drawing rooms from the series *The Young Pope* by Paolo Sorrentino as they learn about and experience first-hand the history and art of the Vittoriano and Palazzo Venezia with the tour dedicated to families, both tourists and inhabitants of the city of Rome, who wish to practice their English. This story-telling tour guides old and young visitors alike through more than 500 years of history, so they can get to know the VIVE in an interactive way and create new connections between art, architecture and cinema. The entertaining visit, which includes short activities along the way, ends on the spectacular panoramic terraces of the Vittoriano.

Entertaining tour for families with children (5-12 years old) of the Vittoriano and the Central Museum of the Risorgimento

What are the colours, shapes and objects that best represent Italy? What are the words and images that storytellers and artists use the most to describe the history of our country? A special tour of the Vittoriano and the Central Museum of the Risorgimento will lead young and old visitors alike to discover the adventures of certain words, such as "homeland", "identity", "future" and "nation" to help them learn how to tell different stories over time. Together we can give shape and colour to our ideas, by imagining compositions of objects, letters and symbols to create original "family manifestos".

Workshop at Palazzo Venezia

In the heart of Rome, on the slopes of the Capitoline Hill, there is a Renaissance palace that looks like a fortress. Its crenellated walls enclose a nineteenth-century garden inhabited by parakeets, soaring palm trees, magnolias and plants that come from the four corners of the world. Immersed in the greenery of Palazzo Venezia's *Rediscovered Garden* and surrounded by dappled light created by the flowers, trees and water of the splendid marble fountain, participants will be able to observe the surrounding nature, record every variation in light and colour, and experience first-hand the practice of plein-air painting like the famous Impressionist painters.

\rightarrow The Rediscovered Garden

Dramatised guided tour for families with children (5 - 12 years old) at Palazzo Venezia Once upon a time... there was a car park like many others, but this particular car park was hiding a big secret: an ancient garden, where popes, diplomats and artists, the residents or illustrious guests of Palazzo Venezia, once walked. Among hydrangeas, pine trees, magnolias and a magical grove of acanthus, a special dramatised narrative tour will lead visitors to discover a story inside history, that will conjure images of adventurous journeys and incredible feats and teach visitors lots of curious facts that are just waiting to be uncovered.

A hanging garden, a market, a gigantic stage, even a traffic island: leafing through the real and planned maps of Piazza Venezia is like looking at an illustrated history book. A journey that takes visitors from the Renaissance architecture of Palazzo Venezia through to the modern-day Vittoriano monument to discover the historical and artistic events that transformed these places into truly iconic sites and allows them to create an emotional map as a family, in which the details, colours, styles and impressions that captured their attention are made visible.

Participants can 'don the cap' of special collectors to create a unique family collection.

An engaging narrative will lead visitors through the rooms of the Central Museum of the Risorgimento and inside the Vittoriano, to discover the colours, symbols and curiosities related to the past and present uniforms of those who have defended and still defend our homeland. A very unique history of costume that intertwines history, popular mythology and ideals, which we can still reflect on today. Thanks to dedicated educational support, we will be able to reinvent original uniforms for famous characters.

Designed for sighted, visually impaired and non-sighted visitors, this inclusive tour will engage participants in a guided journey of the imagination not only through words, but also touch, sound and olfactory experiences.
